



Make a Mobile or Diorama **Book Report**

You are going to create a mobile or diorama that teaches other people about your book! You should include cutouts and pictures of important characters and events in your story.

How should you design your mobile or diorama?

- ☆ Mobile: A mobile can be made using a wire or plastic hanger, or many hangers attached to one another. You can then use yarn or string to hang paper drawings from the hanger(s). Be creative, you may construct your mobile any way you want!
- ☆ Diorama: A diorama can be made with a shoebox, with 1 scene in the background of the shoebox. Things should "pop up" in a diorama. Because you will only have room for one scene in your shoebox, the rest of the material to be included in your diorama can be glued on the sides, top, or bottom. Be creative, you may construct your diorama any way you want!

What should you include in your mobile or diorama?

- ☆ Detailed pictures or cutouts of at least 3 characters, including the character's name on the picture/cutout
- ☆ A detailed picture/cutouts of your favorite scene from the story, with a description of the scene written on the back.
- ☆ One piece of paper glued on your diorama or hanging from your mobile that has the following information written on it:
