

Make your own Travel Brochure Book Report

Create your own travel brochure that will make people want to visit the setting of your book! You should imagine that your job is to attract people to visit your novel's setting, and that you are making a brochure to teach people about the place where your story takes place!

How should you design your travel brochure? (Include all of these!)

- You should use a piece of white construction paper and fold it into thirds. The front of your brochure should have the name of the place where your story took place as well as an attention-grabbing illustration. You may organize the rest of the brochure in any way you choose.
- ☆ If your story has more than one setting, choose your favorite setting, or the one that is most important to the plot of the story

What should you include in your travel brochure? (Choose at least 4!)

- ** If your setting really exists, this information needs to be true. If your setting is a fictional place, you may use your imagination to create this information. ***
 - $\stackrel{\star}{lpha}$ A description of the appearance of this location
 - ☆ The history of this place
 - ☆ A map of this place
 - Information on sites/places of interest
 - $\not\simeq$ Information on local activities of interest
 - ☆ Places for visitors to eat or stay the night
 - ☆ Helpful information for tourists
 - ☆ Important events that occurred in this place (you may include fictional examples of events from your novel or real events found in research you conduct)

Make your own Travel Brochure Checklist

Before you turn in your travel brochure, make sure that you have included all of the following things:

Your travel brochure should be a piece of white construction paper folded into thirds.

Front of brochure:

- o name of the place where your story took place
- o an attention-grabbing illustration

Choose at least 4 of these to include:

A description of the appearance of this location
 The history of this place
 A map of this place
 Information on sites/places of interest
 Information on local activities of interest
 Places for visitors to eat or stay the night
 Helpful information for tourists
 Important events that occurred in this place (you may include fictional examples of events from your novel or real events found in research you conduct)
